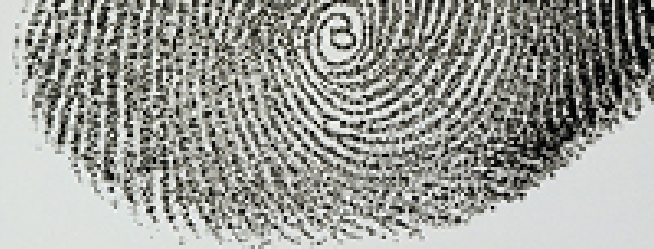

1. The first time you receive an encrypted message from us, you'll need to complete a brief enrollment process to ensure your identity is secure. (See Figure 1)

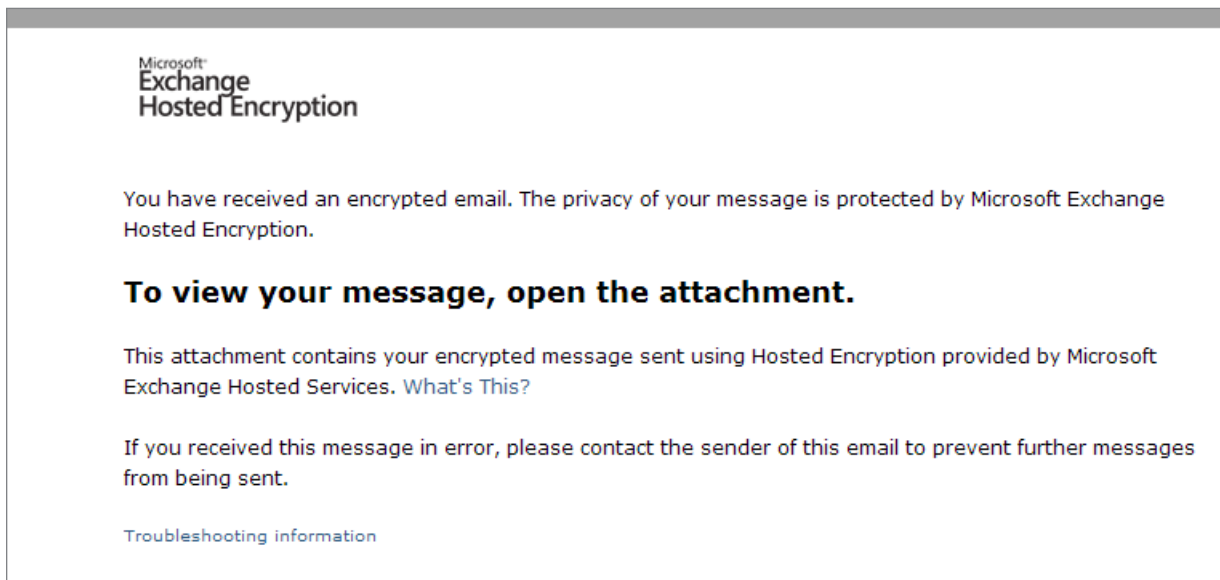

2. Upon opening the attachment that appears in your email, you will be requested to click the button to read your message. (See Figure 2)

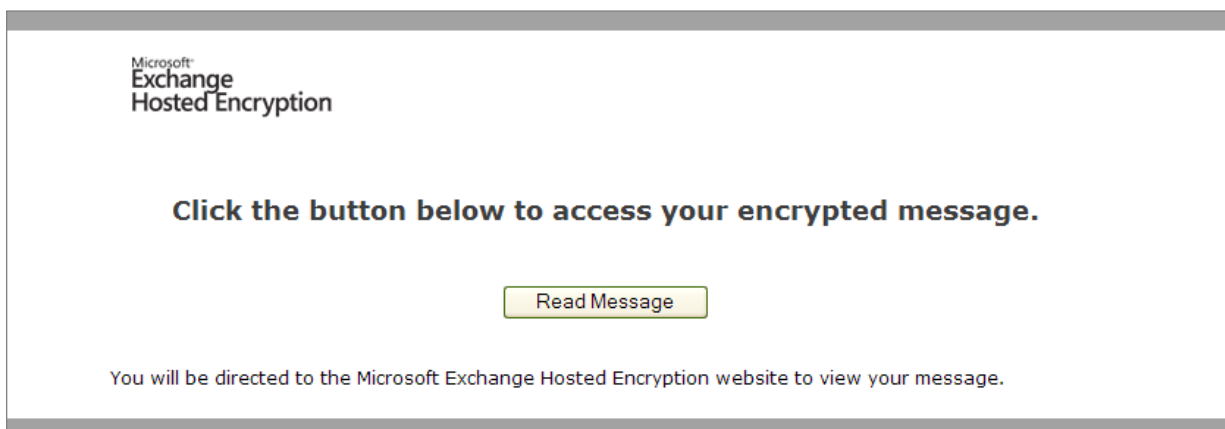

3. Once the Read Message button is clicked, you'll be prompted to start the one time enrollment process. To enroll, input your name and choose a password with six (6) or more characters and no spaces. (See Figure 3)
